Please follow this guide to connect to gateways of terminals of the MOEX Equity & Bond, FX and Money Markets via Internet:

## Make sure DNS service operates correctly

Make sure servers with IP addresses 91.203.254.10 and 91.203.252.10 are in the list of DNS servers of the TCP/IP protocol configuration.

Run the Windows command line: press "**Win"+"R"** and type "CMD" in the opened window. Select "**nslookup trade.moex.com"** in the command line window.

- + When the command is run, field "Addresses" contain the following addresses: 85.118.180.41, 85.118.177.41, 85.118.180.42 and 85.118.177.42.
- If after executing the command, you get an error instead of the list of addresses, please contact MOEX system administrator to check DNS.

# Check the connection addresses availability

Execute consecutively the following commands in the command line window:

To check availability of the Equity & Bond Market gateways:

```
telnet 85.118.180.42 15004
telnet 85.118.177.42 15004
telnet 85.118.177.41 15004
telnet 85.118.180.41 15004
```

To check availability of the FX Market gateways:

```
telnet 85.118.180.42 15000
telnet 85.118.177.42 15000
telnet 85.118.177.41 15000
telnet 85.118.180.41 15000
```

To check availability of the Money Market gateways:

```
telnet 85.118.180.42 15002
telnet 85.118.177.42 15002
telnet 85.118.177.41 15002
telnet 85.118.180.41 15002
```

- + After every command is executed, black screen with a blinking cursor should appear that means successful connection has been made. To execute the next command, press "ctrl"+"C".
- if the error message appears that says *«telnet is recognized as an internal or external command"*, please contact your system administrator to check accessibility of addresses and connection ports.
- if the error message appears that says "Could not open connection to the host, on port: Connect failed" please contact your system administrator to receive authorisation to access the pairs of addresses and connectivity ports.

### Make sure terminals' connection setups are correct

We recommend changing the connection setup when the markets are closed and check in advance correct resolution of the DNS record "trade.moex.com" and network accessibility of connection addresses.

! If parameter "HOST" has already set to a value that differs from trade.moex.com or servers with addresses 85.118.177.41, 85.118.180.41, 85.118.177.42 and 85.118.180.42, new setup should be agreed with your system administrator.
